**Activities and projects in 2013/2014.**

- Project 2013: Contest for the creation of a poster by groups of pupils from six secondary schools in the domain of the Information and Communication Technologies (ICT); the theme 'Be a global citizen' has been chose from a speech by the UN Secretary General Ban Ki-Moon at the University of Luxembourg in April 2012; the ceremony for the prize-winners of the contest will be followed by the inauguration of an exhibition of all the posters on the main school campus of the city of Luxembourg.
- Environment, climate change and food security for a sustainable development: participation to the conference in Brussels in February 2013, given by the professors J-P van Ypersele, vice-president of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) and O. De Schutter, UN Special Rapporteur on the Right to Food; follow-up on these topics with the establishment and the update of corresponding document files; article to be published in the daily Luxembourg press; eventual collaboration (advocacy, ...) in this area with other UNAs or the WFUNA.
- Voluntary Civic Service accomplished in the office of ALNU (UNA Luxembourg) by a graduate student, Ms Caroline Reviriot, with the support of the 'Service National de la Jeunesse' in Luxembourg; the foreseen period of this Youth service is one year.
- Enhancement of the communication framework of ALNU towards the institutions, associations, persons, ... with an existing relationship or a potential interest.
- Project 2014: Second edition of a Model UN / Simulation of the Security Council of the United Nations for the pupils from a large circle of secondary schools.

To be investigated further:

- Invitation of a guest speaker, i.e. Mr Marc Bichler, Executive Secretary of the UN Capital Development Fund (UNDCF).
